6. **FDI Graduates Refresher Training**

The Faculty Development Institute (FDI) organized a refresher training at Hyatt Regency, Boudha, Kathmandu, on January 5, 2025. Our PMCC Lions Sunil Bhakta Shrestha, LCIF District Coordinator Lion Dhana Prasad Lamichhane and GLT District Coordinator Lion Ratna Bahadur Shrestha participated in this important training session, which focused on refining leadership and facilitation skills.

7. **A month long Health Camp**

The Salinadi Mela Mega Health Camp was successfully organized by District 325D with the support of 42 different clubs, the Leo Council, Nepal Medical College, Shankarapur Municipality, Nepal Bharat Maitri Hospital, Shree Madhav Narayan Salinadi Mela Samiti, and various organizations. Thousands of devotees and people benefited from this large-scale health initiative.

The health camp provided various medical services, including emergency rescue, general health checkups, eye and dental camps, and free diabetes screening for an entire month. The initiative also served as a branding effort for Lions International, with over 50 informational signboards displayed prominently throughout the fairground. According to the Salinadi Mela Samiti, more than 2.5 million people visit the Swasthani Temple and the Salinadi Mela annually.

This agreement ensures subsidized healthcare services for Lions members and their families in District 325D.
