Now, I would like to present the activities of our District for the period of July 01, 2024 to August 14, 2024 including other notable activities.

1. District Cabinet Officers’ Announcement

On May 18, 2024, District Governor Lion Surendra Prakash Balay, PMJF, unveiled his cabinet for the Lionistic Year 2024-2025 at a special event held at Chhimeki Party Palace in Jorpati. The announcement highlighted his vision for the upcoming year and introduced the team of dedicated Lions who will support him in achieving their collective goals. 2. Training to Elect District Governor and Secretariat
