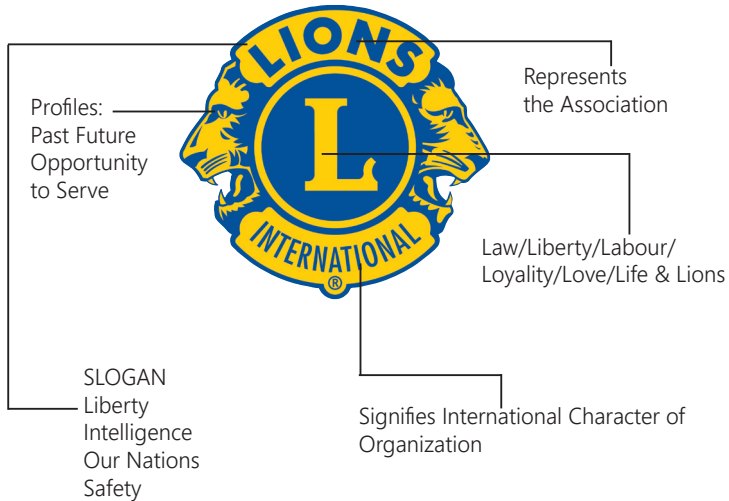

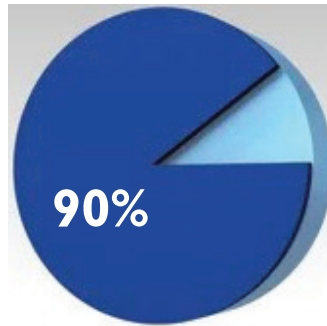

Welcoming New Members: Each club is encouraged to happily add four new members, fostering growth and diversity within the organization.

Welcome Back Campaign: Special campaigns aimed at re-engaging and welcoming back former members, emphasizing the value of their experience and contributions.

Membership Fund: Promote the adoption of long-term membership (by establishing dues fund and service fund) to ensure sustainability and commitment within the clubs.



New Clubs Extension:

New Club Chartering:
Supports the establishment of 15 new clubs by providing financial incentives, thus expanding the reach and impact of the organization.

New Lions Club Extension: 15 (Fifteen)

(Seed Money support for first 10 Clubs Chartered (Rs 10,000/- with Gong and Gavel for every new club inside Kathmandu Valley and Rs15,000/- with Gong and Gavel for every new club outside Kathmandu Valley)

Membership and Club Targets:

NLF Contribution Plan We are calling on all clubs to actively engage in the NLF Contribution Plan. Our aim is to have **at least members of 80% clubs contribute in NLF**, with an expected total collection of **NPR 10,00,000** for the NLF Fund. **70% clubs take Club NLF membership**. This collective effort is crucial for the sustainability and growth of our initiatives.

LCIF Contribution Plan:



We encourage **each club to contribute, with pleasure, a minimum of \$50** towards the LCIF Contribution. Additionally, we request that **cabinet officers**, including Coordinators, Chiefs, Advisors, Deputy Coordinators, Area, Region, Zone, and District Chairpersons contribute at least **\$50** each to LCIF. Our overall **target of LCIF contribution is \$18,500**, which we aim to achieve through MJF and LCIF Star contributions. Club contribution to LCIF will be encouraged. **90% of clubs contribute to LCIF** by individual or club donation. This support is vital for advancing our mission and expanding our impact globally.

Fellowship Programs

Badminton Tournament: A badminton tournament exclusively for Lions, enhancing team spirit and sportsmanship within a district.



Futsal Tournament: A futsal tournament for clubs within the district, fostering inter-club relationships.

Evaluation Criteria

- **Club Good Standing:** Maintenance of good standing status for the club.
- **District Program Participation:** Active involvement in district programs such as Cabinet meetings and workshops.
- **Payment of Dues:** Adherence to deadlines for international, multiple, and district dues.
- **Financial Contributions:** Prioritisation of financial support for LCIF / NLF and service activities.

2. Encouraging Criteria:

- **Service Impact:** Evaluation based on the number, quality, and community impact of service projects, as well as alignment with Lions International's global causes.
- **Contributions to MJF/LCIF/NLF:** Support and contributions to these funds in alignment with global causes.

- **Leadership:** Demonstrated leadership qualities, coordination and innovation in project execution, and mentorship within the club.
- **Membership Growth and Engagement:** Net growth in membership, retention rates, and engagement in club activities.
- **Collaboration and Partnership:** Effective collaboration with other clubs, organizations, and local authorities.
- **Financial Management:** Success in fundraising efforts and transparent use of funds.
- **Public Relations and Visibility:** Efforts to promote Lions Clubs International's mission through various media and community outreach.

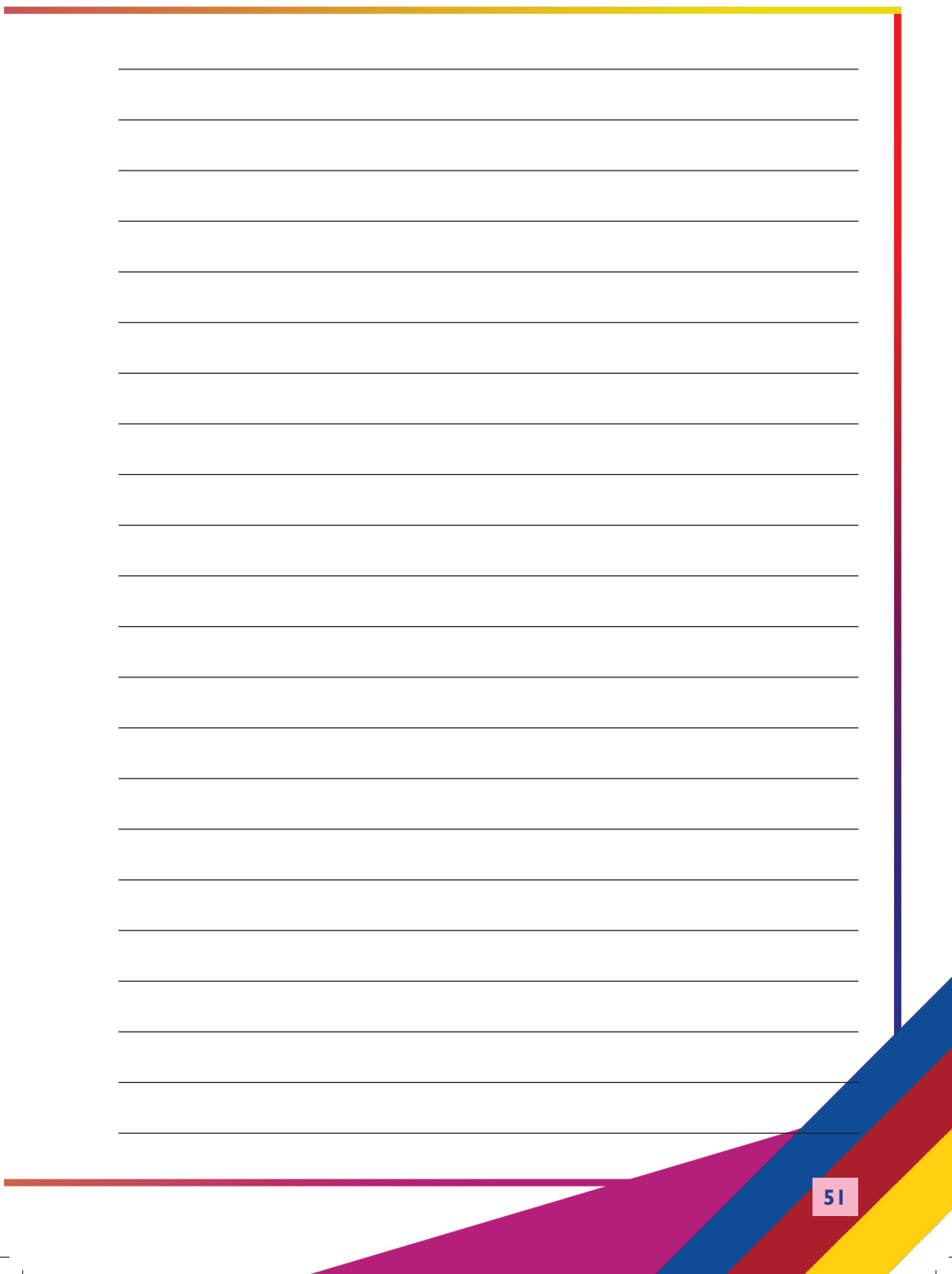

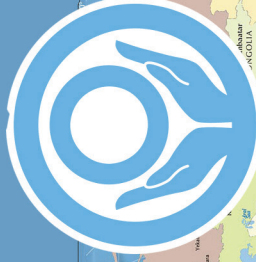
